Notes:

(1) Flagship Competition is off base at Camp Casey Conference Center, Coupeville, WA. Cadets report Friday and depart on Sunday. The unit will provide transportation to the event. Members are responsible for their own return transportation.

(2) The Auburn Veterans Day Parade is off base in downtown Auburn, WA. Members are responsible for transportation to and from the event.

(3) Cadet Enrollment Day is a regular meeting for officer staff, X Division cadet staff and squadron operations division staff cadets, except squad leaders. It is optional for other cadets.

(4) Annual Inspection is held on base. This drill is mandatory, no excused absences will be granted. Members who fail to attend could face disciplinary action up to and including Commanding Officer's mast.

(5) Rock 'n' Roll Marathon is off base. This is an optional event, however because it is both a community service and unit fundraising event, substantial involvement by both parents and cadets (50 to 70 people) will be needed.

(6) Admin day provides limited offices hours on base for cadets to retrieve or return service records, obtain uniform items or take care of other administrative matters.

(7) SeaFair is off base. We will need cadet and parent volunteers to man booths at Seattle Pier 66 and Pier 91 to provide the public with information during Navy ship tours. This is also a unit fundraising event. Cadets not away at summer training are expected to serve at least six to eight hours of duty during the 5-day event for August drill credit.

(8) Jim Creek drill is held off base at Jim Creek Recreation Area, Arlington, WA. Cadets report on Friday and depart on Sunday. Transportation arrangements are to be determined.
