1. Purpose. To promulgate the FY2019 (1 Oct 2018-30 Sep 2019) drill schedule.
2. Cancellation. This notice is cancelled on 30 Sep 2019.
3. Drill Dates and Attendance. Enclosure (1) contains the drill calendar for FY2019. Per references (a) through (c), cadets who fall below a 75 percent attendance rate during the calendar year (1 Jan to 31 Dec) may be subject to removal from the program. Reference (d) defines attendance categories (regular, mandatory and optional) and types of absences (excused, unexcused, unauthorized and training duty). 4. Drill Hours. Regular drill hours are 0745 to 1600. Alterations are announced each month in the plan of the month. We encourage parents to attend quarters (closing formation) at 1530, this is when important announcements are made including promotions, awards. Regular drills usually secure at 1600, meaning all cadets need to depart the base by this time. Senior staff cadets may be required to attend after-hours staff meetings that go beyond 1600.
5. Action. Department heads and division supervisors shall ensure their members comply with this schedule.

he **Auburn Veterans Day Parade** is off base in downtown Auburn, WA. Members are responsible for transportation to and from the event.

Annual holiday party and gift exchange. Family and guests are invited to attend the ceremony.

(3)

Cadet Enrollment Days and/or Staff Meetings are regular meetings for officer staff, X Division cadet staff and Squadron Operations Division staff cadets (squad leader and above). Assisting with enrollment days are optional for other cadets.

(4)

Admin days provide limited offices hours on base for cadets and parents to retrieve or return service records, obtain uniform items, sign up for training or take care of other administrative matters.

(5)

Annual Inspection, Awards and Parade of Cadets is held on base. This annual formal ceremony is mandatory, no excused absences will be granted. Members who fail to attend could face disciplinary action up to and including Commanding Officer's mast. Family and guests are invited to attend the ceremony.

(6)

Canada Exchange Trip will be open to Sea Cadets only. Eligible cadets will be selected from among the top performing cadets. Participants will be required to obtain a passport, passport card or state enhanced ID card/drivers license.

(7)

Rock 'n' Roll Marathon is off base. This is an optional event, however because it is both a community service and unit fundraising event, substantial involvement by both parents and cadets (50 to 70 people) will be needed.

(8)

SeaFair is off base. We will need cadet and parent volunteers to man booths at Seattle Pier 66 and Pier 91 to provide the public with information during Navy ship tours. This is also a unit fundraising event. Cadets not away at summer training are expected to serve at least four hours of duty during the 5-day event for August drill credit. Extra hours may serve as a "make up" drill.
